## SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- 1. Registration is mandatory for scientific paper/poster/table top presentations.
- 2. One delegate will be allowed to present either paper or poster, not both.
- 3. For paper, only one presenter is allowed.
- 4. For poster, maximum two presenters allowed.
- 5. For faculty paper/ poster one presenter allowed.
- 6. For Table Top presentation, maximum three participants are permitted (all participants need to register, however, they have to fill only one scientific submission form).
- 7. Abstract (Word format) for paper/ poster should not exceed more than 200 words.
- 8. The abstract should not be plagiarized as this can lead to rejection of paper/poster.
- 9. Overall best paper will be considered for publication in prestigious Journal of Government Dental college & Hospital, Mumbai, *International Journal of Advanced Dental Sciences (IJADS)*.
- 10. The last date for complete presentations/poster slide submission: 20/11/2022.

## **GUIDELINES FOR PAPER PRESENTATION**

- 1. The total time allotted for presentation
  - Faculty 10 minutes (8 min for presentation + 2 min for question-answer session)
  - Postgraduate/Undergraduate/General Practitioner 8 minutes (6 minutes for presentation
    - + 2 minutes for question—answer session).

Your presentation will not be considered for competition if you exceed time.

- 2. Maximum slides allowed -15 (excluding title and references)
- 3. Use the common fonts like Times New Roman/ Ariel/Calibri.
- 4. Yours slides must be readable, even at the back of the room.
- 5. The heading of each slide shall be 36-40 font size.
- 6. The body of the slide should be 28-32 font size.
- 7. Keep animations to bare minimum until and unless they are absolutely necessary.
- 8. High quality pictures should be included for the presentation.
- 9. The tables and graphs should be readable.
- 10. Use the colors wisely in presentation. The presentation should be made on the custom slide format provided.
- 11. Paper code should be mentioned on the top right corner.
- 12. All slides must be numbered.
- 13. The identity of the presenter/college/guide/co-guide should not be revealed at any time during or in the presentation.

## **GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTATION**

- 1. The total time allotted for presentation
- Poster presentation for all categories 5 mins (3 min for presentation + 2 mins for question- answer session)
  - Your presentation will not be considered for competition if you exceed time.
- 2. Posters to be submitted in the form of e-poster only, in JPEG landscape format at 300 dpi resolution on a single slide.
- 3. Use the common fonts like Times New Roman/ Ariel/Calibri.
- 4. Yours slides must be readable, even at the back of the room.
- 5. Keep animations to bare minimum until and unless they are absolutely necessary.
- 6. High quality pictures should be included for the presentation.
- 7. The tables and graphs should be readable.
- 8. Poster code should be mentioned on the top right corner.
- 9. The identity of the presenter/college/guide/co-guide should not be revealed at any time during or in the presentation.

## TABLE TOP PRESENTATION

- 1. The total time allotted for presentation
  - Table Top presentation 8 minutes (6 minutes for presentation + 2 minutes for question–answer session).
