ANTI-RAGGING POLICY

Ragging is a display of disorderly conduct, any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to a student in any educational institution.

Ragging in any form will not be accepted or tolerated in the institution premises and has adopted a 'Zero tolerance policy' against ragging. The institution has an anti-ragging committee which has been constituted as per the guidelines given by the **University Grants Commission (UGC)**.

The members of the committee consist of the Dean, who is the chairperson, an officer in charge, all the heads of the departments, representative members civil administration, local media, Non Governmental Organizations, Parents, Senior and Junior students. In case any student experiences any such incident in the form of teasing, threatening, physical harm or abuse, it should be immediately reported to the authorities.

Any such incident reported will be immediately investigated by the committee members as per the directions given by UGC and strict action will be taken against the student involved in ragging.

Every student has to provide an undertaking for anti-ragging through the online portal.

Any student found guilty of being involved in ragging shall be punished as per the law. The punishment may range from being debarred from examination, being expelled from the hostel, withdrawal of scholarship to expulsion from the institute.

Guidelines for students to report ragging:

If any student feels that he /she is being harmed in any way, the student has to bring it to the notice of the authorities immediately.

If any incident occurs in the hostel, the hostel wardens must be immediately contacted and reported.

If any incident occurs in the college premises, the student shall approach the members of the anti-ragging committee and report the incident.

The students must not delay the reporting of the incident to the authorities.

If any incident happens after the college hours, the student can contact officer in-charge, members of the anti-ragging committee or the Dean over the phone and report the incident immediately. The

contact numbers of all the members are displayed at various sites in the college and hostel premises.

- › If any student witnesses any of his friends or colleague being involved in any incidents, he/she must not remain a silent spectator, but immediately alert the authorities.
- › Any student who is becomes a victim, after reporting the incident to the authorities, must stay calm and not panic or get anxious, until help arrives.
- › The authorities who receive the information will immediately get into action and instantly make help available for victim and take him/her to a safe place.
- › The matter will be brought forward to the committee which will conduct the enquiry on an urgent priority basis.
